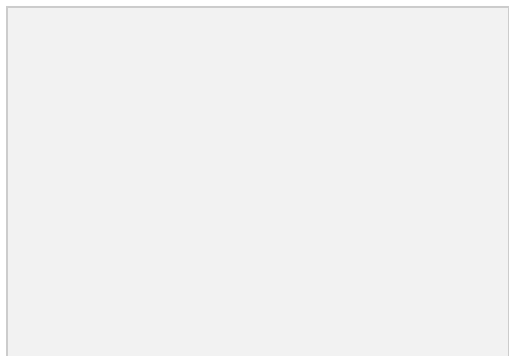
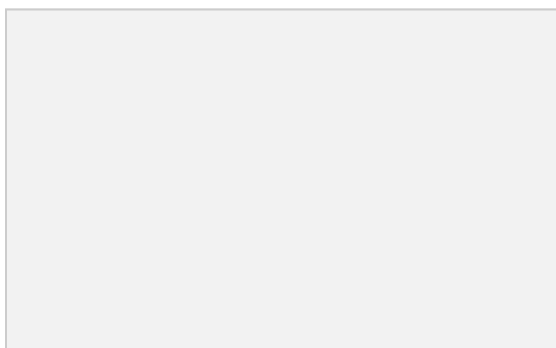
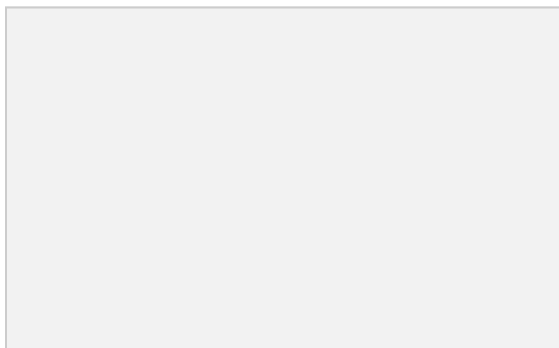
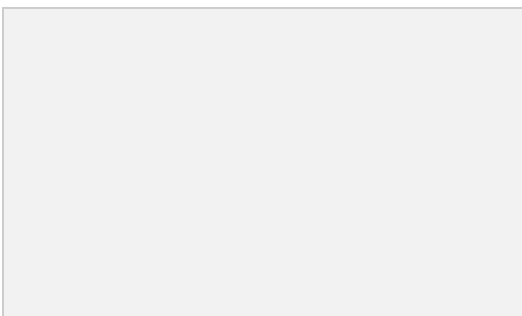
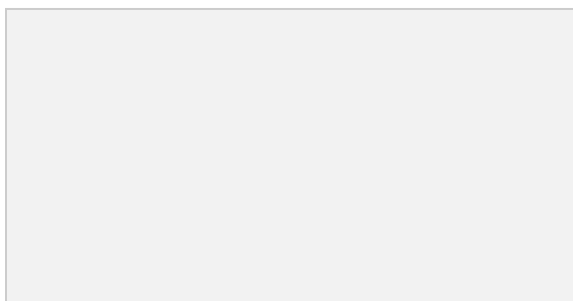
**75 Years Jubilee Celebration 08<sup>th</sup> October – 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2023.**

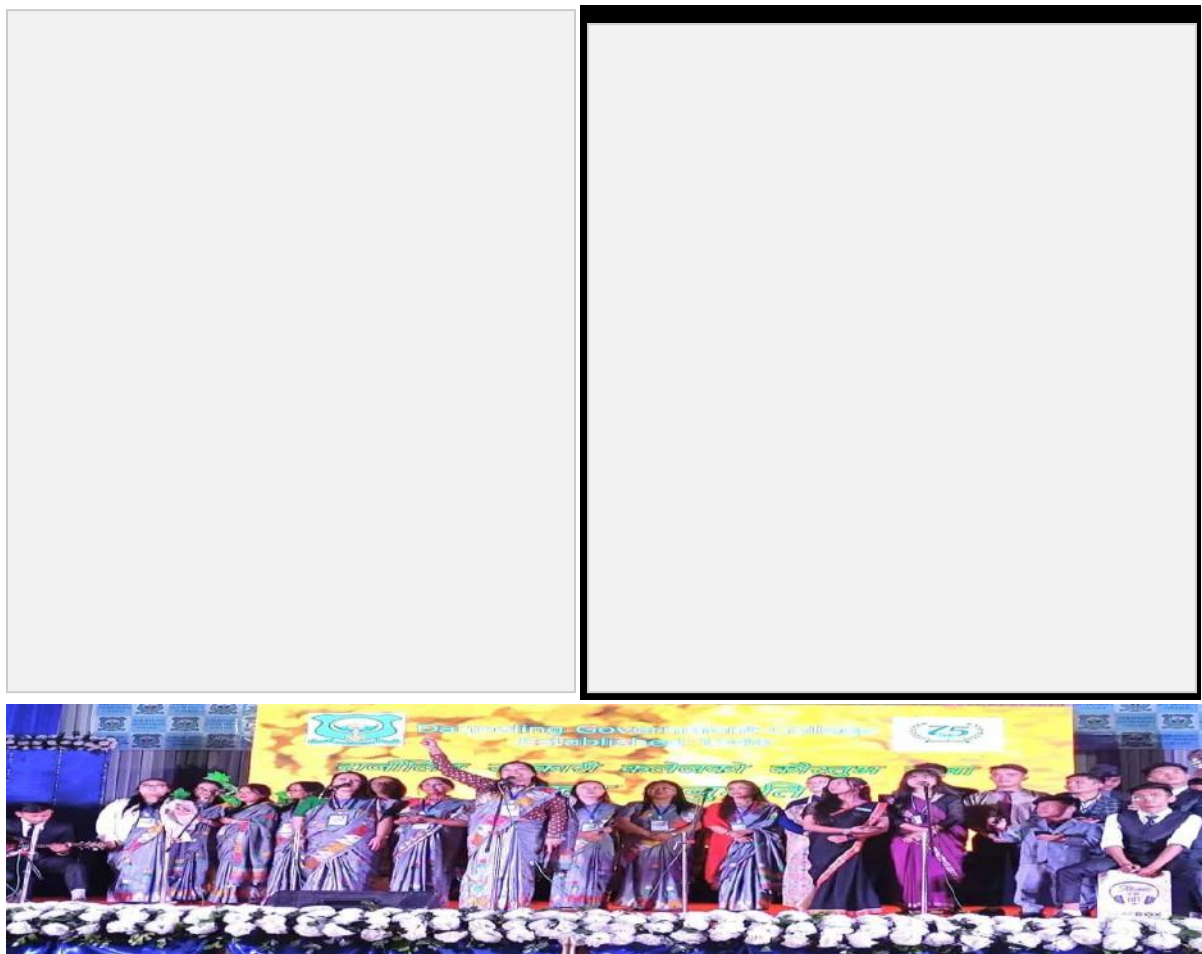
### **Inter college sports meet on 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> October 2023**

Teachers Day Celebration of Political Science Department, 2023





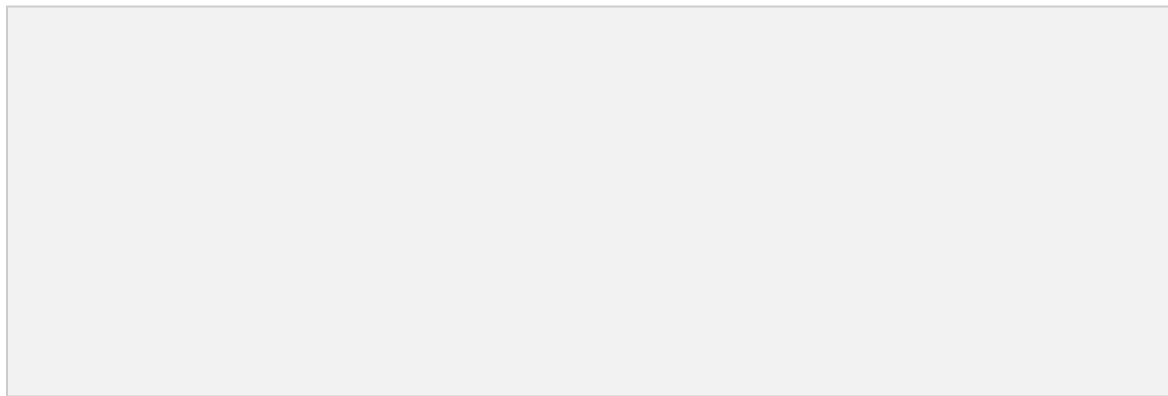
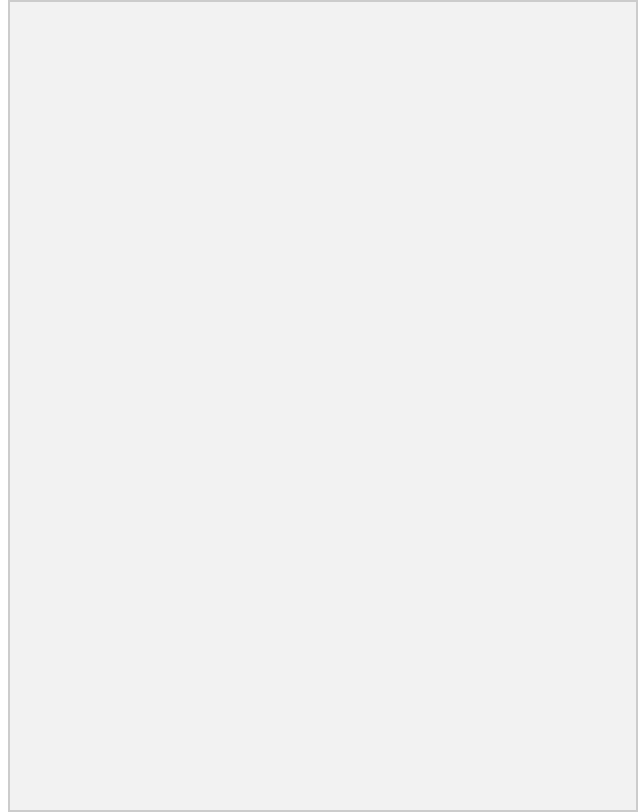
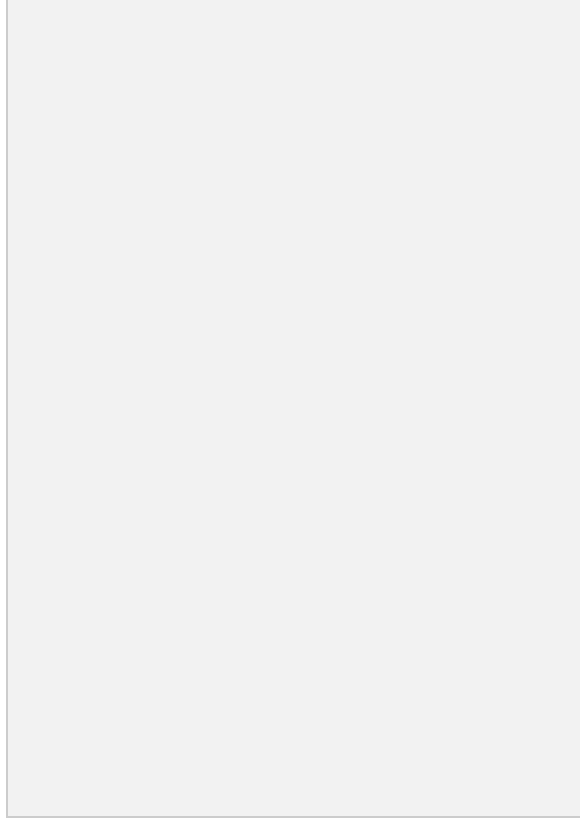

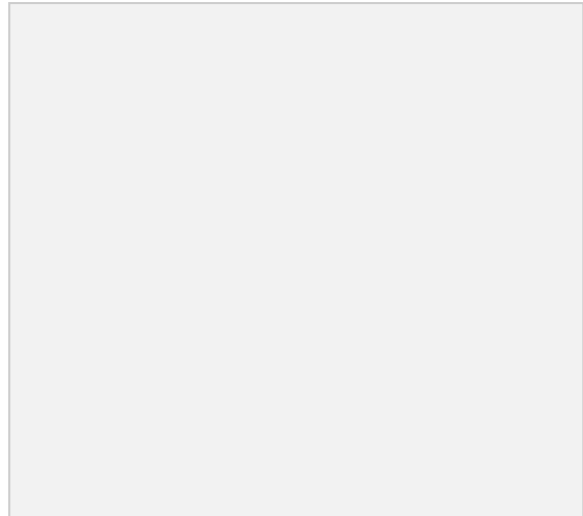
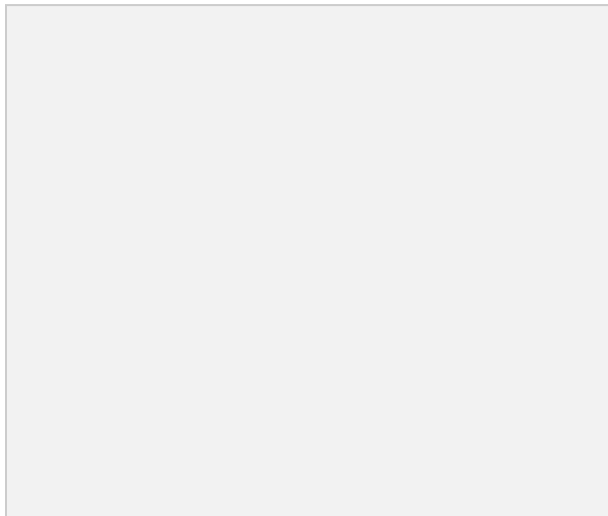
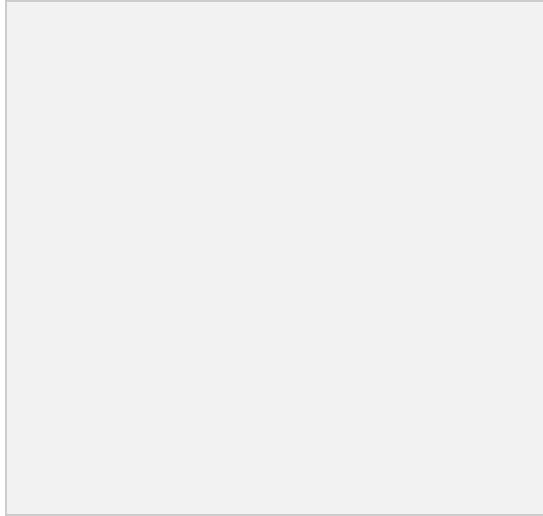


## **Wall Magazine**
