# Student Satisfaction Survey Report (2021-2022)

Student satisfaction surveys are an important tool for measuring the effectiveness of education and identifying areas for improvement. By gathering feedback from students about their experiences in the classroom, the College can gain valuable insights into what is working well and what needs to be changed. The Institution regularly takes feedback from the students regarding teaching -learning experience and College Infrastructure. This feedback helps the College to work on the shortcomings in its work as well as to make informed decisions about curriculum development, teaching methods, and resource allocation.

Conducting a student satisfaction survey can also improve communication and build trust between students and teachers. By giving students a voice and actively seeking their input, educators can demonstrate that they are committed to creating a positive learning environment. This can increase student engagement and motivation, leading to improved academic performance and greater student success.

The College resumed the offline classes in the month of November 2021. The opening of classes after the prolonged period of Covid-19 induced lockdown led to the blended mode of teaching-learning. Both the online and offline classes started simultaneously. This feedback survey is focused on both the online and offline mode of teaching-learning.


#### THE RESONDENTS

The Student Satisfaction Survey for the year 2021-2022 was conducted with the help of the questionnaire survey. A total of **2251** students out of 3250 attempted the questionnaire and gave us feedback on the teaching-learning and infrastructural facilities of the college. **About 69** % of Students responded to the feedback from both the Under Graduate and Post Graduate Courses.

The questionnaire was divided into three heads- teaching-learning facilities (Educational feedback), Administrative Infrastructure and Support and Extracurricular activities.

91.9% of Undergraduate students from different streams and 8.1% of Post Graduate students from P.G. department of Nepali, English, Zoology and Botany participated in the survey.




About 64% of the respondents were female and only 36% of respondents were male.




Most of the respondents (89%) are staying as "Paying Guest in and around college and 11% reside in the Hostels of the College.

### **TEACHING-LEARNING FACILITIES (EDUCATIONAL FEEDBACK)**

The regularity of the class is important for any students to complete their courses in time. 92 % responded that they do attend the classes regularly. Only 1% of them responded that they attend class twice a week and 6% of them thrice a week. And only 1% of the students attend class once in a week .




The regularity of the class is further supported by the communication of cancellation of classes in advance by the teachers to the students as such classes can be used by the other faculty members who are present in the department. 34% responded that they are informed in advance regarding the cancellation of the class while 27 % responded that they do not get informed regarding such. While 39 % responded that they do sometimes gets informed regarding cancellation of classes in advance.

A total of 54% of students responded positively that the syllabus gets covered in a given time frame followed by 31% who responded that about *70 to 84* % of the syllabus is covered in a given time.

Whereas 55-69% (9% responses) and 30-54%(5% responses) gets covered for some students and *less than* 30% syllabus gets covered (1% responses) as per the rest of the students in the given time frame.






records.93% of students responded that teachers do maintain regular attendance while 1 % responded in negative. 6 % also responded that the teachers do sometimes maintain the record.












# Administrative and Infrastructure Support



The library is the heart of any academic institution. And the College boasts of having one huge central Library for the College and separate seminar libraries for all the departments of the College. The collection of books, journals & reading materials was found to be good to very good by 71 % of students while 25% of students found it 4% found average and them be to poor.



The operation of a library is in the hands of the library staff. The librarian position has been vacant for few years now and it was running with the help of the non-teaching staffs and library sub-committee of the College. But with the joining of the new Librarian, it is expected to play a huge role in the students' academic development.

In this survey, 83 % of students have found the support and assistance of the library staff to be good to very good. 15 % found them average while 2 % of them responded that they did not receive any desired help.



The College has 6 science departments (Zoology,Botany,Microbiology,Physics,Chemistry & Mathematics) and Geography department Laboratories. These labs have rich collection of the required chemicals and substances and instruments. This question was focused to the students of such departments and 1370 students responded for the survey. 72 % of students found the laboratories in good to very good . while 23 % thought the library infrastructure was average and 5 % found them poor.

For the availability of Common rooms for the students 39% of them has responded positively while 32% said No and 29% are not sure whether separate common rooms for the girls and boys are available.







The college premise is clean and maintained properly as per 71% of the respondents. While 8% of them do not agree and 21% of them thinks it is average.






