

ACTION TAKEN REPORT (2020-2021)

The College was closed and the classes were held online from March 2020 to October 2021. The college reopened in November 2021 after the lockdown.

- The sudden and unexpected complete lockdown presented the need for new methods of teaching and learning and was emphasized by the College in case of any future epidemics.
- The need to maintain hygiene was felt after the Covid, hence sanitation was given top priority in the following months.
- The College felt the need for a medical room for any kind of medical assistance. Hence a proposal was put forward for same.
- For the Completion of the syllabus on time and the regular internal assessment to help the students get the flow of learning after the COVID lockdown, the teachers were asked to take extra care apart from the regular.
- No major actions were taken during this period.

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ACTION TAKEN REPORT Based on the Feedback Report from The Students and the Teachers (2021-2022)

After analysing the feedback reports from the students and the teachers, the following action was taken by the College.

- 8. The feedback was that most of the students were satisfied with the completion of the syllabus and the study environment.
- 9. The need for smart classrooms is felt by both the teachers and students. In this regard, the officerin-charge asked the departments to prepare a list of infrastructure needed by the departments to the College Infrastructure Committee College.
- 10. The space crunch for the teachers in the canteen has been spoken to the Canteen.
- 11. To encourage the students into extracurricular activities, the College Sports Committee is asked to keep a regular awareness program and display information on the College Notice board to encourage participation in the overall development of the students.
- 12. As a part of sanitary health of the female students under the able guidance of Officer-In-Charge of DGC, Dr. Prajjwal Chandra Lama, Dr. Subrata Kar (Head, Department of Commerce), Dr. Prabir Sen (Head, Department of Chemistry), Prof. Sheela Karjee (Department of Economics) and Prof. Priyanka Saha (Department of Zoology) joined hands to start this initiative of installing sanitary napkin vending machine and incinerator in the College as a part of menstrual health of the female students and teachers. It must be mentioned here that the machines were not funded by the Government, but rather by the voluntary contribution of the teaching faculties of the College.
- 13. Among the facilities provided to the students, Darjeeling Government College came up with the initiative of providing a "Medical Assistance Room" for the students during medical emergencies equipped with first-aid facilities (wound cleaning solution, cotton, bandage, band-aid, gauze, spirit, red-lotion, hand gloves, masks, towels, painkillers, thermometer) and blood pressure-measuring machine starting November 2023.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT Based on the Feedback Report from The Students and the Teachers

(2022-2023)

After analyzing the feedback reports from the students and the teachers, the following action was taken by the College.

- 14. Most of the students were satisfied with the completion of the syllabus and the study environment, yet the heads of departments were advised to look into the day-to-day activities of the departments to help the students fare better.
- 15. The need for smart classrooms is felt by both the teachers and students. In this regard, the College Infrastructure Committee has already prepared a list of infrastructure submitted by the departments to the College authority for further action.
- 16. The problem of hygiene in the College has been a long-standing problem. The College has only two sweepers (out of 7 posts) who are unable to keep the huge area of the College clean. The maintenance of hygiene in the washroom is the responsibility of the user and the cleaner. Hence the Student Health and Hygiene Committee was asked to raise awareness about their responsibility to the students regularly.
- 17. One of the factors resulting in the sanitation problem was the water connection. The College Authority has installed new connections to solve this problem to some extent and is expected to get more connections shortly.
- 18. For the most important problem of drinking water facilities, the College has received 3 water purifiers from the Department with water connection in the coming year of 2024. It is expected to provide drinking water to almost 80 percent of the students and the teachers.
- 19. To encourage the students into extracurricular activities, the College Sports Committee is asked to keep a regular awareness program and display information on the College Notice board to encourage participation in the overall development of the students.
- 20. The space crunch for the teachers in the canteen has been spoken to the Canteen.
- 21. The College authority has asked College Placement cells to be more active and help students in their career advancement.
